Divisions: Div 2 (B), Div 3 (C), Div 4 (D). **NOTE: Maximum of 16 teams for the tournament with each pool no more than 4 teams. (Subject to no. of teams entered)**

NOTE: Priority will be given to earlier entries with the correct payments

Conditions:

1. The maximum number of players of a team is 6. Each round requires at least 2 ladies and 2 men.
2. Team players may be changed before the commencement of each round but not during a round.
3. **Players for each round are to be ranked at the commencement of the round and shall play against players of equal ranking for the round. A pair with a higher ranked player will be deemed to rank higher for the round irrespective of the ranking of the partner. A player may not play in more than 2 matches in a round. The competition organiser reserves the right to re-grade or re-rank players.**
4. Divisions may be combined if there are insufficient teams in a division.
5. The competition is in a Round Robin format. Each round is made up of 1 ladies' doubles, 1 men's doubles and 2 mixed doubles matches. The number of games and game points for each match is subject to the number of entries.
6. The winning team is determined by the most number of games won, failing that, the most points won, failing that, the least points lost. A final will be played if there is more than one pool in the same division.
7. A maximum of 6 trophies will be presented to the winning team of each division.
