The Carnival is open to year 7 to 12 students who **are not current or past state badminton representatives**. A novice division for those who are inexperienced or new to the sport is also be available. The event is played in a round robin format within each pool of teams. The players are ranked by their relative strength and play against other team players of equal ranking. Each rubber is composed of 2 singles and 3 doubles games, allowing the students to enjoy badminton to the full.
